1. Loan for Students laptop:

2. New structure of CDC:

- CDC asks if it possible to keep the old members of CDC, while adding two members from outside (maybe one from VDC, one from PFA), so that there are 7 members of CDC

→ fear, that influence from outside could get too high

- other possibilities: 4 from workers: 3 from outside: 1 chairperson
3 from workers: 2 from outside: 1 chairperson

> CDC send delegation, to get back the fertilizer

> CDC got back one bag, the other one was already applied.

> worker will give back remaining amount of K13000 by the end of February

> the bag which was gotten back will be sold

K 500,000 were already used


for K 582,000 materials were bought

• one glass for headmaster's house




