Water supply for Chipunga First Primary School

Dear Daniel
Dear CDC members

During my last stay we discussed the lack of a functioning water supply and the bad sanitation and hygiene situation at Chipunga Primary School. GRACE agrees that safe water is important and could reduce cases of water borne diseases. In the interim I could find a donor who might cover the cost for installing a water supply at the school and to run an accompanying hygienic training.

The request of the donor is to have a situation analysis about the exact need.

Given the fact we are going a) either to repair the existing well or b) have to drill a new well my beg to CDC is the following:

- 1/ *Discuss the idea with the responsible local chief*
- 2/ *Discuss the idea with the headmaster / PTA*
- 3/ *Provide info about how many pupils plus people from the community will benefit from the water source*
- 4/ *Describe the problem with the existing whole (what, why, since when)*
- 5/ *Do a little research on who in Malawi can do such a work and what the cost will be*
- 6/ *Send us your analysis, input, and recommendations (every snapshot is welcome)*

As mentioned the donor wants to run in a hygienic training with the community people as well. Further you should think about a person who is responsible to do the necessary work to maintain the water well.

Please give feedback as soon as you got ideas and my questions answered. To speed up the process I will forward this information to the Antonia, Vincent, Bernhard, and Renata from DED.
