REPORT FOR WHAT WE HAVE DONE IN MONTH OF APRIL 2011

WATER HOLE

I would like to confirm that the water hole at the compound has been completed, though we have not yet put up the cover. But the cover was already made only that it is not dry that we can carry and cover. As you have already seen by the snap shot sent by Maya during the day of our duty.

I hope next week from 1st-15th of May we are going to put on the cover.

This will be a work for almost thirty minutes. We have also asked our Health Severance Assistance to give us chlorine for our water. He has accepted to do so because he will also be using the same water hole.

PRE-SCHOOL

Both schools are working. Though the one from the compound has opened this week that was on 5th May 2011. But it has started with a high moral. Again the school from the compound as I said last time that it was under construction now it has finished and on 4th May we had a grand opening party. We invited the parents of the learners elected committee, chiefs, V.D.C. and others. People recommended a good work done by Vincent Schnell. He asked some help from the GIZ and his home village to support the community of Chipunga. The room is looking very nice and attractive to other people from other communities.

The Pre-school from the church has been transferred from church to Chipunga Primary school. They have given one of the teacher houses, that was built by pupils of Chipunga Primary School. The house is nearby the house of the headmaster Mr. Ngwira. Antonia has also started to renovate the building she has painted some of the letters and animals plus other things in the house, though she did not finish but after her completion I hope that the building will also look attractive.

We have received funding from certain lady who visits Chipunga for a week. She is the girlfriend of Leander one of the part-time worker in Chipunga who came from Germany and he has been with us for 6 months. Before she arrived in Malawi she did some fund raising in the place where she is working, she is working in Switzerland. The money that we have received is 11,250 MK and Vincent also added some money which was left for reconstruction of Pre-school amounting to 15,250 MK. This money we have been told that we should select 30 children for both Pre-schools that they should pay 50% school fees for 9 months. This means that the pre-school committee should do everything, 15 learners from each side. The community is aware about this funding and they have already started to do their meetings for this issue.

For the letter of 4th-6th April I have organized some meetings with the chiefs and other committees in the community next week Tuesday, after this when I will reply the letter.
